ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On January 6, 2011, the Court entered an order (doc. 36) staying all proceedings in the instant case pending resolution of the parallel state-court proceedings. The Court instructed Plaintiff to notify the Court once the state court had conclusively determined the true identity of the Episcopal Diocese of Fort Worth and the Corporation. Pursuant to those instructions, Plaintiff filed a Notice of Conclusive Determination by State Court (doc. 38) on April 7, 2011, indicating that the identity issues had been resolved.

Accordingly, no later than **May 2, 2011**, Defendant must show cause in writing as to why the Court should not lift the stay imposed by the January 6 order. Should Defendant fail to do so, or should the Court find Defendant's reasoning unpersuasive, the Court will lift the stay.
